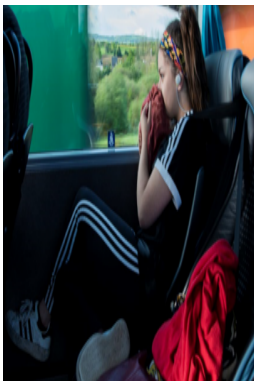


Marie-Anne Goujon
