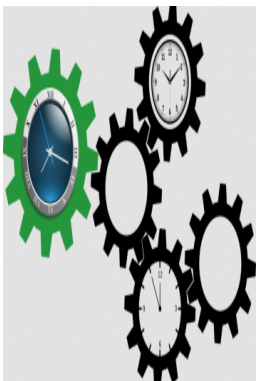


Meike Brodersen

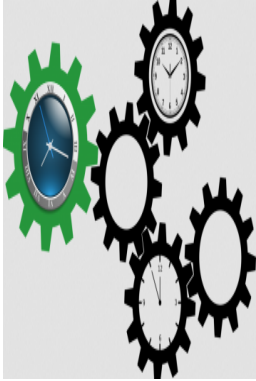
