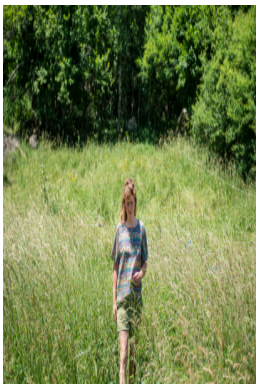


Céline Gaille
